Competition Highlights

1. The competition is open to Engineering and Technology Institutions and UG/PG students from Engineering and Technology disciplines across India.
2. The IoT Society of India will select three institutions from among the registrations received from eligible institutions for participation in the event. Each institute selected may nominate 3 students. The institute is permitted to participate only once in the competition.
3. The students will also be selected from among the individually registered participants from any institution and invited to deliver their extempore speech during the event.
4. Participation certificates, awards, and recognition for students and faculty coordinators as per the competition guidelines.
5. The IoT Society of India may organize multiple online speech competitions to accommodate the maximum number of institutions and students.

Selection of Topic for Speech

- ❖ The list of IoT-based topics is provided in the competition guidelines.
- ❖ Each contestant will be offered **two topics** by the judge from the list of topics. The contestant may choose **one** of the two topics for the extempore speech.
- ❖ Alternatively, if the contestant has prepared a topic from the list of competition topics, they may opt to deliver their speech on that prepared topic instead.
- ❖ Please note that 10 marks are allotted for the topic given by the judge.

Panel of Judges

- ❖ The IoT Society of India shall nominate a panel of up to seven (7) judges from across the country. The panel shall consist of advisers, divisional chairpersons, office bearers, members of the Society, and other eminent IoT professionals from academia and industry.
