GUIDELINES FOR THE ONLINE EXTEMPORE SPEECH COMPETITION ON IoT-BASED TOPICS

1. OBJECTIVE

- ✓ Promote awareness and understanding of Internet of Things (IoT) technologies.
- ✓ Enhance communication and critical thinking skills among engineering students.
- ✓ Encourage innovative ideas for solving real-world problems using IoT.
- ✓ Provide a national platform for students to express their technical knowledge and creativity.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ Open to undergraduate and postgraduate engineering students from institutions & universities.
- ◆ Present and previous members / institutional members / student chapters of the IoT Society of India.

3. PROCEDURE

- ◆ The IoT Society of India will select three institutions from among the registrations received from eligible institutions for participation in the event. Each institute selected may nominate 3 students. The institute is permitted to participate only once in the competition.
- ◆ The students will also be selected from among the individually registered participants from any institution and invited to deliver their extempore speech during the event.
- ◆ The name of the student will be announced during the event.
- ◆ The student must be present online when their names are announced. If a student is absent or unavailable at the time of the event, the opportunity will be offered to the next eligible participant.
- ◆ The IoT Society of India may organize multiple online speech competitions to accommodate maximum institutions and students.
- ◆ Preference will be given to the present and previous members / institutional members / student chapters of the IoT Society of India.

4. Camera must remain ON throughout the competition.
5. Professional attire is recommended.
6. Any use of AI-generated scripts or external assistance during the speech is prohibited.
7. The organizing committee reserves the right to disqualify participants for plagiarism or violation of rules.
8. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.



12. TIME SIGNALS

The event coordinator will inform the contestant about the preparation time (2 Minutes), start, 1 minute remaining and Time up of the period. The contestant is expected to conclude immediately after the final signal.



13. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Participants should ensure:

- Stable internet connection
- Laptop or desktop preferred
- Functional webcam and microphone
- Quiet, well-lit environment
- Neutral background

The organizers will not be responsible for interruptions caused by the participant's internet or equipment issues.
